From the President



Dear Sitwell Rotarians,

We hear the title "Homeless" so often that it almost stops meaning much to all but those who find themselves in the position. To us in our comfortable homes and lives, to be without a place to call HOME must be the most desolate state anyone can be in. For 61 years my Mum lived in a rented house and although she took a pride in it, kept it spotless and decorated it herself, there was a limit as to how far she would go. She refused to have central heating installed or any significant works that would have made her life easier. It was not HER house you see? She thought "Why spend money on someone else's house?" But she regarded it as her home. And therein lies the subtle difference between a house and home. I am undergoing for the first time in my life a sense of "houselessness". My house has been taken over by builders (self-imposed; so do not weep for me) and all my belongings have gone into storage. I am living out of a suitcase until such time as the basics of water, heating and power have returned. I have only been out 5 days but the effect on me is enormous. The emptiness of not having a base, not having my stuff around me and sleeping in hotels (the closest to "rough" I will volunteer to); it is just

not the same as being on holiday or working away from home. Then, you know you are returning home. And eventually I will indeed be returning home to a modernised house I call my own. So many thousands in this country cannot say that. So many millions around the world who lose everything to war and natural disaster are genuinely homeless. Their plight, their complete sense of the disconnection they must feel has only now just hit home with me.
