Bursaries for nurses

Two prospective nurses who have studied at Rotherham colleges have received a boost from Rotherham Sitwell Rotary.

Olivia Marriott from Thomas Rotherham College is now following a degree course in Adult Studies at Sheffield Hallam University.

Adele Boyes who studied Access to Health Science Professions at Rotherham College is now studying Adult Nursing at the Chesterfield campus of the University of Derby.

Two “Rotherham Sitwell Rotary Bursaries for Nurses” (each valued £500) are offered annually: one to a Thomas Rotherham College student and another to a Rotherham College Access Learner.

These bursaries were prompted by the Covid-19 pandemic and are financed from an educational fund initiated by the family of Past President Dr Gurnam Basran. They aim to support student nurses who have received firm offers of places at a local University.
